What is Judo?

Judo is a modern martial art, combat and Olympic sport created in Japan in 1882 by Jigoro Kano. Its most prominent feature is its competitive element, where the objective is to either throw or takedown an opponent to the ground, immobilize or otherwise subdue an opponent with a pin, or force an opponent to submit with a joint lock or a choke. (Adults only). Punching, kicking and weapons are not an active element of Judo, however it is a contact sport. In the UK Judo is governed by the British Judo Association (BJA).

Apollo Judo Club

Apollo Judo Club has been running since 1982, and is an accredited club mark member of the BJA. The club is run by dedicated volunteers with the aim of encouraging as many people as possible to take up the sport, whilst adhering to all relevant policies, procedures and guidelines which are set out by the BJA and other national's organization such as UKCC and the NSPCC to ensure a safe and protected environment.

Pricing Policy

Apollo Judo Club is a community judo club and because of this we try to keep our membership prices as low as possible. We have no annual membership's fees, we only charge mat fees.

Our current fees are: £2 per session for all members

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For the next few weeks we can provide you with everything you need, within six weeks of starting you will need to get a licence from the BJA. This provides you insurance and the ability to move through the grades and enter competitions in pursuit of the coveted Black Belt. The current cost of a license is in the table below.
